Senate Bill 203

Introduced by: Senator Rohl

- 1 An Act to increase the minimum age to purchase a lottery ticket.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 3 Section 1. That § 42-7A-32 be AMENDED:

42-7A-32. No lottery ticket may be sold to any person under the age of <u>eighteen</u> years twenty-one. Any lottery retailer, employee of a lottery retailer, or any other person who knowingly sells or offers to sell a lottery ticket to any person who is under the age of <u>eighteen years</u> twenty-one is guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor on the first offense and a Class 6 felony on the second or subsequent offense. A lottery ticket may be given as a gift to a person under the age of <u>eighteen years</u> twenty-one. Any prize won by a person under the age of eighteen <u>years</u>, from a ticket given as a gift <u>shall</u>, <u>must</u> be paid to <u>such</u> the person's parent or legal guardian, as applicable.
