MOTIONS AND RESOLUTIONS

- SB 50 (Intent to Reconsider Vote by Which Lost) prohibit the use of drones for purposes of assessing real property for taxation, and to provide a penalty therefor. (Introduced)
- SB 60 (Intent to Reconsider Vote by Which Lost) expand the access and investigatory authority of the state auditor. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed)

CONSIDERATION OF REPORTS OF COMMITTEES (AMENDED BILLS)

SB 128 (Consent Calendar), SB 135 (Consent Calendar)

SECOND READING AND CONSIDERATION OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

- SB 97 allow the governing body of a municipality to change the use of municipally owned parkland by ordinance. (Introduced)
- SB 106 require an individual be registered as a voter of this state before being eligible to be a petition sponsor for a ballot measure. (Introduced)

SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- SB 8 establish certain criminal offenses for boat operators and to provide penalties therefor. (Senate Judiciary Engrossed)
- SB 83 revise the penalty and provide treatment for the ingestion of certain controlled substances. (Senate Judiciary Engrossed)
- SB 107 exempt trailer manufacturers and trailer dealers from certain provisions regarding motor vehicle dealer license requirements. (Introduced)
- SB 109 permit a school district to implement a new or revised section 504 plan, individualized family service plan, or individualized education program for a student who is the child of an active-duty member of the United States armed forces. (Senate Education Engrossed)

SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- HB 1014 modify provisions related to emergency medical services personnel and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)
