On page 1, line 8, of the Introduced bill, after "13-1:" delete "No employee of a school district or an institution under the control of the Board of Regents or the South Dakota Board of Technical Education, regardless of the scope of the employee's official duties, may without the written permission of the student's parent or guardian knowingly and intentionally address an unemancipated minor student by:"

On page 1, line 12, of the Introduced bill, after "by:" delete "(1) A name other than the student's legal name or a derivative thereof; or

(2) A student's preferred personal title or pronoun that is inconsistent with the student's sex.

For the purposes of this section and sections 2 and 3 of this Act, the term "sex" means the classification of a person as either female or male based on the organization of the body for a specific reproductive role, as indicated by an individual's sex chromosomes, naturally occurring sex hormones, and internal and external genitalia present at birth."

(1) Provide any instruction or presentation to a student with the purpose of studying exploring, or informing the student about gender identity, gender expression, or the concept that a student's gender may be inconsistent with the student's biological sex at birth;

(2) Encourage or coerce a student to withhold from the student's parent, legal guardian, or other custodian the fact that the student's perception of the student's gender or sex is inconsistent with the student's sex; or

(3) Withhold from a student's parent, legal guardian, or other custodian information related to a student's perception that the student's gender or sex is inconsistent with the student's sex. "
