House Bill 1002 ENROLLED

An Act

ENTITLED An Act to require that all certified educators take a course in South Dakota Indian Studies.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

Section 1. That § 13-1-48 be AMENDED:

13-1-48. All certified educators new to the profession or from out-of-state shall complete a three-credit-hour course in South Dakota Indian studies. The course shall include components specific to:

- (1) Language and cultural awareness;
- (2) History;
- (3) Educational theory and background of the traditional tribal education; and
- (4) Implementation and strategies of Indian learning styles, curriculum development, and authentic assessment.
