- (4) A bill or joint resolution introduced at the request of the Governor, an executive agency, or of the chief justice of the Supreme Court.

The committee shall obtain a written request for such the introduction from either the council Legislative Research Council, the Governor, the department head of an executive agency, a constitutional officer or board, or the chief justice, and shall retain such the request in its file. Committee bills introduced on behalf of a department head of an executive agency, a constitutional officer, or board may be introduced by the chairman chair without a vote of the committee for purposes of prefiling.

Nothing in this section prohibits one or more legislators from introduction of introducing a bill or a joint resolution."
