MOTIONS AND RESOLUTIONS

- HCR 6002 Urging the United States Congress and the President of the United States to remove the requirement of a project labor agreement for federal construction projects. (Introduced)
- HCR 6009 Requesting the attorney general to file a lawsuit against the People's Republic of China and related parties to seek damages related to the COVID-19 global pandemic. (Introduced)

CONSIDERATION OF REPORTS OF COMMITTEES (AMENDED BILLS)

HB 1058, HB 1165, HB 1238, HB 1205, HB 1201

SECOND READING AND CONSIDERATION OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

- HB 1160 waive the driver license renewal period for members of the military and their families, and employees of the state department. (Introduced)
- HB 1139 allow individualized investigative treatments for patients with life-threatening or debilitating diseases or conditions. (Introduced)
- HB 1095 to extend the area in which a director for an irrigation district may reside. (Introduced)
- HB 1063 revise the provisions for preparing a fiscal note for ballot questions. (Introduced)

SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- HB 1189 (Removed from Consent Calendar) extend by two years the date on which moneys appropriated to the Governor's Office of Economic Development in 2021 for marketing, route restoration, business development, and air service marketing will revert to the general fund. (Introduced)
- HB 1208 (Deferred from 19th LD) (JR 5-17 with pending amendment) provide for registration of an overseas citizen or individual using the address of a mail forwarding service or post office box as a national voter. (House State Affairs Engrossed)

- HB 1166 (Deferred from 19th LD) (JR 5-17 with pending amendment)enhance penalties for the violation of right-to-work statutes and to provide a penalty therefor. (Introduced)
- HB 1066 revise residency requirements for the purposes of voter registration. (House State Affairs Engrossed)
- HB 1169 modify the signature requirement for a petition to initiate a constitutional amendment. (House State Affairs Engrossed)
- HB 1216 modify and repeal provisions related to the Legislative Research Council. (House State Affairs Engrossed)
- HB 1220 amend provisions pertaining to the verification of registered voters contained in the master registration file. (House State Affairs Engrossed)
- HB 1188 allow nonresident military members to purchase three-day temporary nonresident waterfowl licenses. (Introduced)
- HB 1180 require that a candidate for election to the board of a school district disclose the candidate's party affiliation on a declaration of candidacy. (Introduced)
- HB 1024 amend certain fees collected by the secretary of state. (Introduced)
- HB 1173 eliminate the cap on assessment amounts for road improvements. (Introduced)
