

<u>SB 178</u>	increase a tax on jet fuel (Introduced) Introduced by: Senator Hohn
SB 194	classify nicotine products as tobacco products, to increase tax rates on cigarettes and tobacco products, to create the healthcare workforce development fund, and to make an appropriation therefor (Introduced) Introduced by: Senator Miskimins
<u>SB 213</u>	exempt any food grown, raised, or otherwise produced in this state from state sales tax (Introduced) Introduced by: Senator Foster
