MOTIONS AND RESOLUTIONS

- HB 1223 (Intent to Reconsider Vote by Which Lost) provide for conscience exemptions from certain vaccinations. (House Health and Human Services Engrossed)
- HB 1260 (Intent to Reconsider Vote by Which Lost) require that birth certificates and certain official documents reflect biological sex. (House State Affairs Engrossed)
- HCR 6003 To provide for an interim study regarding property tax reduction and preservation of the American dream to own a home. (Introduced)
- SCR 607 Encouraging the Legislature to continue using person-first language that acknowledges the person before any disability. (Introduced)

CONSIDERATION OF REPORTS OF COMMITTEES (AMENDED BILLS)

- HB 1195 (Consent Calendar), HB 1200, HB 1232 (Consent Calendar)

SECOND READING AND CONSIDERATION OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

- HB 1116 repeal a reporting requirement regarding industrial hemp. (House Agriculture and Natural Resources Engrossed)
- HB 1265 establish provisions related to the sharing of information with the national marrow donor program. (House Transportation Engrossed)
- HB 1161 allow additional forms to verify military service for a veteran designation on a commercial driver license or commercial learner's permit. (Introduced)

SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- HB 1245 exclude guaranteed payments made to partners from the definition of gross receipts, and to exempt guaranteed payments made to partners from the state use tax. (House Taxation Engrossed)
- HB 1239 revise certain affirmative defenses to dissemination of material harmful to minors and obscenity offenses. (Introduced)
- HB 1174 revise certain provisions related to the rights and obligations of a father of a child born to an unmarried mother. (Introduced)
