Pursuant to this section, the savings amount dedicated to the state animal disease research and diagnostic laboratory bond redemption and operations fund in fiscal year 2018 shall be one million six hundred fifteen thousand dollars. In fiscal year 2019 and each year thereafter, the savings amount dedicated from the general fund to the state animal disease research and diagnostic laboratory bond redemption and operations fund shall be three million three hundred fifty thousand dollars are in place until July 1, 2040.~~"

(5) Meet at least once during each quarter of the year; and

(6) Prepare and submit an annual report to its governing body and to the South Dakota State Library on such forms as may be provided by the State Library."
