MOTIONS AND RESOLUTIONS

HB 1025 (Intent to Reconsider Vote by Which Lost) authorize the Department of Corrections to construct a prison facility for offenders committed to the Department of Corrections in Lincoln County, to make an appropriation therefor, to transfer moneys to the incarceration construction fund, and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)

SECOND READING AND CONSIDERATION OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

HB 1083 modify the requirements for obtaining an agricultural processor's lien. (House Agriculture and Natural Resources Engrossed)  
HB 1230 revise provisions related to, and establish the crime of, unauthorized distribution of fentanyl and provide a penalty therefor. (Introduced)  
SB 93 prohibit payment or rebate of insurance deductibles by contractors providing motor vehicle repair services. (Introduced)

SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

HB 1200 (Deferred from 25<sup>th</sup> LD) (JR 5-17 with pending amendment) permit merit pay as a component of teacher compensation. (House Education Engrossed)  
HB 1213 increase the maximum amount allowable for the livestock ownership inspection fee and to declare an emergency. (House Agriculture and Natural Resources Engrossed)  
HB 1036 establish a minimum combined balance of the budget reserve fund and general revenue replacement fund. (Introduced)  
HB 1167 make an appropriation for the development of South Dakota. (Introduced)  
HB 1168 make an appropriation to enhance the economic health of South Dakota. (Introduced)

- HB 1170 make an appropriation for economic development in South Dakota.

- HB 1026 make an appropriation for the replacement of the Richmond Lake dam and spillway, for the general maintenance and repair of other state-owned dams, and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)
- HB 1092 make an appropriation for a student teacher stipend grant program.  
(House Education Engrossed)

#### SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- SB 65 provide for the sale of certain real estate located in Pennington County and to provide for the deposit of the proceeds. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)
- SB 109 permit a school district to implement a new or revised section 504 plan, individualized family service plan, or individualized education program for a student who is the child of an active-duty member of the United States armed forces. (Senate Engrossed)
- SB 71 revise provisions pertaining to the compulsory age for school attendance.  
(Senate Engrossed)
