

On page 1, line 6, of the Introduced bill, after "facilities." delete "Section 2. The Incarceration Task Force consists of the following members:

- (1) Two officers of a state correctional facility, appointed by the secretary of the Department of Corrections;
- (2) Two wardens or former wardens of a state correctional facility, appointed by the secretary of the Department of Corrections;
- (3) Two members of the Senate, appointed by the president pro tempore of the Senate;
- (4) Two members of the House of Representatives, appointed by the speaker of the House of Representatives; and
- (5) Two representatives of the Unified Judicial System, appointed by the chief justice of the Supreme Court."

On page 1, after line 16, of the Introduced bill, insert: "

**Section 2. The Incarceration Task Force consists of the following members:**

- (1) Two members of the House of Representatives, appointed by the speaker of the House of Representatives;
- (2) Two members of the Senate, appointed by the president pro tempore of the Senate;
- (3) One former inmate, appointed by the president pro tempore of the Senate;
- (4) One law enforcement officer, as defined by § 23-3-27, appointed by the South Dakota State's Attorneys Association;
- (5) One state's attorney, appointed by the South Dakota State's Attorneys Association;
- (6) One public defender, appointed by the South Dakota State's Attorneys Association;
- (7) One circuit court judge, appointed by the chief justice of the Supreme Court;
- (8) One court administrator, appointed by the Unified Judicial System;
- (9) One court services officer, appointed by the Unified Judicial System;
- (10) One parole agent, appointed by the Department of Corrections,
- (11) One corrections officer, appointed by the Department of Corrections,
- (12) One member of the clergy who is involved in prison ministry, appointed by the Executive Board of the Legislative Research Council;
- (13) One qualified mental health professional, as defined by § 27A-1-3, appointed by the Executive Board of the Legislative Research Council
- (14) One addiction and prevention practitioner, as defined by § 36-34-1, appointed by the Executive Board of the Legislative Research Council;
- (15) The Secretary of the Department of Corrections; and
- (16) A representative from the Governor's office."
