CONSIDERATION OF REPORTS OF COMMITTEES (AMENDED BILLS)

HB 1242, HB 1005, HB 1037, HB 1039

SECOND READING AND CONSIDERATION OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

- HCR 6011 Urging the Trump-Vance administration and Office of Management and Budget to uphold the Reagan administration policy of government-to-government relations with tribal nations. (Introduced)
- HCR 6013 Supporting the Electoral College, denouncing the National Popular Vote Interstate Compact, and inviting interested states to form the Electoral College Interstate Compact. (Introduced)
- SB 111 permit a court to order family therapy or reunification therapy in a custody or visitation dispute. (Introduced)

SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- HB 1083 (Removed from Consent Calendar) modify the requirements for obtaining an agricultural processor's lien.
(House Agriculture and Natural Resources Engrossed)
- HB 1016 revise provisions related to pharmacy. (House Appropriations Engrossed)
- HB 1085 establish a moratorium on the construction of carbon dioxide pipelines in this state and to declare an emergency.
(House Commerce and Energy Engrossed)
- HB 1114 make an appropriation for the purchasing of equipment to support the South Dakota Board of Technical Education. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)
- HB 1115 establish the crime of aggravated criminal entry of a motor vehicle with the intent to steal a firearm or firearm silencer, to make offenders ineligible for presumptive probation, and to provide a penalty therefor.
(House Judiciary Engrossed)
- HB 1131 make an appropriation for the restoration, maintenance, and repair of the state capitol. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)

- HB 1235 reduce a limit on the annual increases of property tax revenues payable to certain taxing districts, and to subject school districts to a limit on property taxes collected in a year. (House State Affairs Engrossed)
- HB 1249 protect landowners from the use of deception, fraud, harassment, intimidation, misrepresentation, or threat, in acquiring easements or easement options. (House Commerce and Energy Engrossed)
- HB 1242 limit the amount of money that may be transferred to a candidate campaign committee, a political action committee, or a political party by the authorized committee of a candidate for federal office. (House State Affairs Engrossed)
- HB 1005 remove the requirement for payment of a private home study by the Department of Social Services. (House Appropriations Engrossed)
- HB 1037 amend the tax collection allowance credit for filing returns and remitting taxes electronically. (House Appropriations Engrossed)
- HB 1039 amend the programs reimbursing a teacher or school counselor for earning national board certification. (House Appropriations Engrossed)
- HB 1186 provide for the revision and eventual repeal of the employer's investment in South Dakota's future fee. (Introduced)
- HB 1135 provide opportunities for South Dakotans. (Introduced)
- HB 1149 make an appropriation benefitting South Dakotans. (Introduced)
- HB 1150 address issues facing South Dakota. (Introduced)
- HB 1204 revise the subpoena powers of the Government Operations and Audit Committee. (Introduced)
- HB 1013 increase weights and measures inspection fees charged by the Department of Public Safety. (House Commerce and Energy Engrossed)
- HB 1038 repeal provisions regarding the state payment for burial of veterans. (Introduced)
- HB 1040 reduce the state's contribution to a subsidized high school dual credit program. (Introduced)
- HB 1228 require an environmental impact statement from applicants seeking a carbon dioxide transmission facility permit from the Public Utilities Commission of the State of South Dakota. (Introduced)

SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- SB 93 (Removed from Consent Calendar) prohibit payment or rebate of insurance deductibles by contractors providing motor vehicle repair services. (Introduced)
