SB 73 amend the definition of principal residence with regard to driver licenses to conform to voter registration requirements. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed)

SB 150 (Removed from Consent Calendar) improve South Dakota. (Introduced)

SB 164 prohibit the use of a deepfake to influence an election and to provide a penalty therefor. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed)

SB 169 require a public hearing prior to a vote to impose an excess tax levy. (Senate Taxation Engrossed)

SB 188 amend eligibility to vote by absentee ballot. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed)

SB 191 limit annual valuation increases on owner-occupied single-family dwellings and nonagricultural property. (Senate Taxation Engrossed)

SB 193 allow an applicant to have an interpreter present during the driving portion of a driver license exam. (Senate Local Government Engrossed)

SB 216 reduce the growth in the assessed value of owner-occupied property, limit increases in certain property tax revenues, and revise eligibility requirements for a property tax assessment freeze. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed)
