On page 4, line 16, of the Senate Judiciary Engrossed bill, after "34A-2:" delete "The department may not provide an aggregated list, regardless of physical form, containing the address, geographic coordinate systems location, or legal location of a concentrated animal feeding operation with coverage under a general or individual water pollution control permit issued pursuant to § 34A-2-36, except as required by federal law or regulation, or at the discretion of the department in response to a request from a South Dakota state agency or local government for information regarding a permitted operation in the jurisdiction of the agency or local government."
