SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

SB 6 make an appropriation to support capital and infrastructure projects necessitated by the expansion of Ellsworth Air Force Base and to declare an emergency. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)

SB 16 set aside certain contractor's excise tax collections relating to the Ellsworth Air Force Base, to create a fund for the collections, and to provide an appropriation therefor. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)

Individuals needing assistance, pursuant to the Americans with Disabilities Act, should contact the Legislative Research Council (605-773-3251) 48 hours before convening to make any necessary arrangements.

- SB 45 impose a motor vehicle technology fee. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)
 SB 56 authorize the payment of lease rental obligations to the South Dakota Building Authority by the Bureau of Finance and Management, to make an appropriation therefore, and to declare an emergency. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)
 SB 95 make an appropriation to the Department of Revenue for distribution to county rural access infrastructure funds and to declare an emergency. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)
 SB 132 make an appropriation for grants to support airport terminal improvement and expansion. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)

SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- HB 1094 modify laws regarding school bus safety and to provide a penalty therefor. (Introduced)
 HB 1114 (Deferred from 29th LD) make an appropriation for the purchasing of equipment to support the South Dakota Board of Technical Education. (House Engrossed)
 HB 1131 (Deferred from 29th LD) make an appropriation for the restoration, maintenance, and repair of the state capitol. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)
 HB 1192 remove the maximum fee permitted to be charged by a notary. (Introduced)
 HB 1196 (Deferred from 29th LD) update Uniform Unclaimed Property Act to include provisions related to virtual currency and notice requirements. (Introduced)
 HJR 5001 (Deferred from 29th LD) Proposing and submitting to the voters at the next general election an amendment to the Constitution of the State of South Dakota, conditioning the requirement of expanded Medicaid on the level of federal medical assistance. (Introduced)
 HJR 5002 (Deferred from 29th LD) Applying to the United States Congress under Article V of the United States Constitution to call for a convention for proposing an amendment to the constitution establishing congressional term limits. (Introduced)
