MOTIONS AND RESOLUTIONS

HB 1071 (Consideration of Senate Amendments) modify practice criteria for physician assistants. (Senate Health and Human Services Engrossed)

CONSIDERATION OF REPORTS OF COMMITTEES (AMENDED BILLS)

SB 91 (Consent Calendar), SB 175

SECOND READING AND CONSIDERATION OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

- SB 92 require that the director of the Legislative Research Council and the secretary of state review an initiated measure and determine if the measure embraces more than one subject. (Senate Engrossed)
- SB 145 require legislative approval of real property leases that are necessary for the operation of state government and exceed specified durations or rental payments. (Senate Appropriations Engrossed)
- SB 185 amend provisions pertaining to the process by which the qualifications of a registered voter are verified. (Senate Engrossed)
- SB 171 add questions about historical property to seller's disclosure statement. (Senate Commerce and Energy Engrossed)
- SB 58 revise provisions related to human trafficking, to prohibit the obstruction of human trafficking enforcement, and to provide a penalty therefor. (Introduced)

SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- SB 75 require an indication of United States citizenship status on a motor vehicle operator's license or permit, and on a nondriver identification card. (House State Affairs Engrossed)
- SB 176 clarify the discovery procedures and powers and to modify the administration of the Government Operations and Audit Committee. (House State Affairs Engrossed)
- SB 24 revise provisions relating to the promulgation of rules to set licensing and inspection fees for plumbers and related professions. (Introduced)
