MOTIONS AND RESOLUTIONS

Senate Page Resolution 4

- SB 75 (Consideration of House Amendments)require an indication of United States citizenship status on a motor vehicle operator's license or permit, and on a nondriver identification card. (House State Affairs Engrossed)
- SB 176 (Consideration of House Amendments)clarify the discovery procedures and powers and to modify the administration of the Government Operations and Audit Committee. (House State Affairs Engrossed)
- HCR 6003 To provide for an interim study regarding property tax reduction and preservation of the American dream to own a home. (Introduced)
- HCR 6009 Requesting the attorney general to file a lawsuit against the People's Republic of China and related parties to seek damages related to the COVID-19 global pandemic. (Introduced)

SECOND READING AND CONSIDERATION OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

- HB 1005 modify the requirement for payment of a private home study by the Department of Social Services. (House Engrossed)
- HB 1061 prohibit a health care provider from restricting or denying a parent or guardian's access to certain medical records and other health information of a minor. (House Health and Human Services Engrossed)
- HB 1139 allow individualized investigative treatments for patients with life-threatening or debilitating diseases or conditions. (Introduced)

- HB 1225 update and repeal provisions related to the reporting of hospital charge information. (Introduced)
- HCR 6011 Urging the Trump-Vance administration and Office of Management and Budget to uphold the Reagan administration policy of government-to-government relations with tribal nations. (Introduced)
- HCR 6013 Supporting the Electoral College, denouncing the National Popular Vote Interstate Compact, and inviting interested states to form the Electoral College Interstate Compact. (Introduced)

SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- HB 1066 revise residency requirements for the purposes of voter registration. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed)
- HB 1116 (Removed from Consent Calendar) repeal a reporting requirement regarding industrial hemp. (House Agriculture and Natural Resources Engrossed)
- HB 1174 (Deferred from 32nd LD) revise certain provisions related to the rights and obligations of a father of a child born to an unmarried mother. (Introduced)
- HB 1204 revise the subpoena powers of the Government Operations and Audit Committee. (Introduced)
- HB 1235 reduce a limit on the annual increases of property tax revenues payable to certain taxing districts, and to subject school districts to a limit on property taxes collected in a year. (House State Affairs Engrossed)
- HB 1249 protect landowners from the use of deception, fraud, harassment, intimidation, misrepresentation, or threat, in acquiring easements or easement options. (House Commerce and Energy Engrossed)
- HB 1259 prohibit unauthorized access to certain multi-occupancy rooms. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed) (Fiscal Note)
