- HB 1016 (Consideration of Senate Amendments) revise provisions related to pharmacy and to increase fees. (Senate Engrossed)

SB 191

SECOND READING AND CONSIDERATION OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

- SB 73 require that an individual registering as a voter when applying for a driver license be a resident of this state for the purposes of voting. (House Transportation Engrossed)
- SB 173 revise the process by which a recount may be requested. (Introduced)
- SJR 505 Proposing and submitting to the voters at the next general election an amendment to the Constitution of the State of South Dakota, establishing the trust for unclaimed property fund. (Senate Engrossed)
- SB 88 increase the amount of exempt proceeds when a homestead is sold or divided by court order. (Senate Judiciary Engrossed)
- SB 115 revise a provision related to sexual contact with a child under eighteen. (Introduced)
- SB 164 prohibit the use of a deepfake to influence an election and to provide a penalty therefor. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed)
- SB 215 remove the prohibition against a landowner having an easement on the landowner's property. (Senate Judiciary Engrossed)

## SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- SB 131 (Deferred from 30<sup>th</sup> LD) establish an electronic system for vehicle titles. (Senate Transportation Engrossed)
- SB 90 (Removed from Consent Calendar) clarify provisions regarding tax deeds. (Introduced)
- SB 169 require a public hearing prior to a vote to impose an excess tax levy. (Senate Taxation Engrossed)
- SB 6 (Deferred from 32<sup>nd</sup> LD) transfer certain moneys and create a fund to support capital and infrastructure projects necessitated by the expansion of Ellsworth Air Force Base. (Senate Engrossed)
- SB 68 require an individual be a citizen of the United States before being eligible to vote and to provide a penalty therefor. (House State Affairs Engrossed)
- SB 14 revise and repeal provisions related to agricultural production facilities and to provide a penalty therefor. (House Agriculture and Natural Resources Engrossed)
- SB 113 provide protections for parental rights. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed)
- SB 143 modify the composition and staffing requirements of the South Dakota-Ireland Trade Commission. (Introduced)
- SJR 503 Proposing and submitting to the voters at the next general election an amendment to the Constitution of the State of South Dakota, clarifying that an individual must be a citizen of the United States to be eligible to vote. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed)
- SB 3 increase driver license fees. (Senate Appropriations Engrossed)
- SB 26 reduce employer contribution rates and increase the administrative fee rate for reemployment assistance. (Introduced)
- SB 28 revise provisions relating to licensing fees and license renewal dates for the practice of barbering and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)
- SB 32 revise amounts for licensing fees for the practice of accountancy. (Introduced)
- SB 64 revise provisions related to the establishment of an initial parole date. (Senate Judiciary Engrossed)
- SB 100 limit the imposition of restrictions on the carrying of a concealed pistol and other items of self-defense while on the campus of a public institution of higher education. (Senate Engrossed)
- SB 216 reduce the growth in the assessed value of owner-occupied property, limit increases in certain property tax revenues, revise provisions regarding school district excess tax levies, and revise eligibility requirements for a property tax assessment freeze. (Senate Engrossed)
