SECOND READING AND CONSIDERATION OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

HB 1007 prohibit use of the South Dakota public utilities commission gross receipts tax fund for reimbursement of costs incurred by the Public Utilities Commission. (Senate Commerce and Energy Engrossed)

HB 1039 amend the programs reimbursing a teacher or school counselor for earning national board certification. (House Appropriations Engrossed)

HB 1143 require that the director of equalization adjust certain agricultural land values. (Senate Local Government Engrossed)

HB 1230 revise a provision related to unauthorized distribution of fentanyl and provide a penalty therefor. (Senate Judiciary Engrossed)

Individuals needing assistance, pursuant to the Americans with Disabilities Act, should contact the Legislative Research Council (605-773-3251) 48 hours before convening to make any necessary arrangements.

HB 1264 require the disclosure of an outstanding loan balance on a campaign finance disclosure report. (Introduced)

SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

HB 1208 designate an individual using the address of a mail forwarding service or post office box when applying to register as a voter or vote by absentee ballot as a federal voter. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed)

HB 1066 (Deferred from 33rd LD) revise residency requirements for the purposes of voter registration. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed)

HB 1005 (Removed from Consent Calendar) modify the requirement for payment of a private home study by the Department of Social Services. (House Engrossed)

HB 1135 provide opportunities for South Dakotans. (Introduced)

HB 1165 provide a means by which an agricultural producer may request an automatic refund of an assessment on crops. (House Engrossed)

HB 1169 modify the signature requirement for a petition to initiate a constitutional amendment. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed)

HB 1184 amend the deadline for filing a petition to initiate a measure or constitutional amendment. (Introduced)

HB 1218 prohibit counties, municipalities, and townships from imposing firearm restrictions on certain employees, officers, and volunteers. (Senate Local Government Engrossed)

HB 1235 (Deferred from 33rd LD) reduce a limit on the annual increases of property tax revenues payable to certain taxing districts, and to subject school districts to a limit on property taxes collected in a year. (House State Affairs Engrossed)

HB 1239 revise certain affirmative defenses to dissemination of material harmful to minors and obscenity offenses. (Introduced)

HB 1242 limit the amount of money that a political action committee may accept from an authorized committee of a candidate for federal office. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed)

HB 1245 exempt from the state sales and use tax gross receipts for certain services to a partnership. (Senate Taxation Engrossed)

HB 1249 (Deferred from 33rd LD) protect landowners from the use of deception, fraud, harassment, intimidation, misrepresentation, or threat, in acquiring easements or easement options. (House Commerce and Energy Engrossed)

HB 1256 require the inclusion of certain information on a candidate's nominating petition or on a ballot question petition. (House State Affairs Engrossed)

HB 1259 (Deferred from 33rd LD) prohibit unauthorized access to certain multi-occupancy rooms. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed) (Fiscal Note)

HJR 5003 Proposing and submitting to the voters at the next general election an amendment to the Constitution of the State of South Dakota, requiring that a constitutional amendment receive an affirmative vote of sixty percent of the votes cast before the measure is enacted. (House State Affairs Engrossed)
