SECOND READING AND CONSIDERATION OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

SB 120 update the membership of the Animal Industry Board to include a poultry producer. (Senate Agriculture and Natural Resources Engrossed)

SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

SB 169 (Deferred from 33rd LD) require a public hearing prior to a vote to impose an excess tax levy. (Senate Taxation Engrossed)

SB 164 (Removed from Consent Calendar) prohibit the use of a deepfake to influence an election and to provide a penalty therefor. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed)

SB 95 (Deferred from 32nd LD) make an appropriation to the Department of Revenue for distribution to county rural access infrastructure funds and to declare an emergency. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)

SB 70 modify the maximum sparsity benefit a sparse school district is eligible to receive. (Senate Appropriations Engrossed)

SB 144 require legislative approval for significant capital expenditures by the Department of Game, Fish and Parks. (Senate Appropriations Engrossed)

SB 191 limit annual valuation increases on owner-occupied single-family dwellings and provide an exception for mill rate limitations on taxing districts. (House State Affairs Engrossed)

SB 216 (Deferred from 33rd LD) reduce the growth in the assessed value of owner-occupied property, limit increases in certain property tax revenues, revise provisions regarding school district excess tax levies, and revise eligibility requirements for a property tax assessment freeze. (Senate Engrossed)

SB 127 authorize the expenditure of moneys and make an appropriation for grants supporting airport terminal improvements and expansion. (House Local Government Engrossed)
