- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain provisions relating to jury selection.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 3 Section 1. That § 16-13-2.1 be repealed.
- 4 16-13-2.1. For the purposes of this chapter, the board of jury selectors shall be the clerk of
- 5 the circuit court, the chairman of the board of county commissioners, and the county auditor,
- 6 or if there be no person holding any one or more of such offices in the county, the presiding
- 7 circuit judge shall designate a person to fill the vacancy. If a jury district is utilized, the board
- 8 of jury selectors from each county need not be present during the preparation of the district
- 9 master jury list. The presiding judge shall compile that list from each county's master jury list.
- Section 2. That § 16-13-4.1 be amended to read as follows:
- 11 16-13-4.1. For the purposes of this chapter, the jury selection list shall be prepared using
- 12 electronic means by the state court administrator's office and shall consist of the current voter
- 13 registration list obtained from the secretary of state, supplemented by the list of persons eighteen
- 14 years of age and over holding a valid driver's driver license. The state court administrator's

office shall annually merge these lists, and purge duplicate listings, to create an accurate jury

- 2 selection list for preparing the master juror list in each county. The county auditor may request
- 3 <u>state court administrator's office may specify</u> that the supplemental <u>driver's driver</u> license list
- 4 be compiled from a list of those drivers within the county who have renewed, updated, or
- 5 applied for a driver's driver license in the last two years. The jury selection list may not be
- 6 distributed, sold, or duplicated for any other purpose.
- 7 Section 3. That § 16-13-9.2 be amended to read as follows:
- 8 16-13-9.2. Using a random number, The state court administrator's office shall choose, at
- 9 <u>random, a number</u> not less than one nor more than the total number of jurors to be placed on the
- master jury list. Using that random number, the state court administrator's office shall select
- from the jury selection list for each county the name corresponding to that random number in
- sequence. This process shall continue until the number of names provided for pursuant to § 16-
- 13 13-2 is selected. The processes specified in this section may be performed electronically.
- 14 Section 4. That § 16-13-13 be amended to read as follows:
- 15 16-13-13. Promptly upon receipt completion of the master juror list from the state court
- administrator's office, and in any event before October first in each year, the board of jury
- selectors clerk of courts shall sign and file the list and shall file it with the clerk of courts. The
- list shall be kept on file for four years. The clerk of courts shall then prepare separate tickets for
- each person named in the master juror list furnished by the board of jury selectors, unless a
- 20 name is stricken pursuant to § 16-13-15. This process may be performed electronically.
- 21 Section 5. That § 16-13-15 be amended to read as follows:
- 22 16-13-15. The board of jury selectors <u>clerk of courts and county auditor</u> shall ascertain
- 23 whether each of the persons on the master juror list has the qualifications of a juror as provided
- by § 16-13-10 from the information available to the board from records of the county or other

- 1 readily available sources, or has served as a juror within two years. A person has served as a
- 2 juror if that person has been summoned and appeared for a trial. If, from examination of the
- 3 master juror lists at any time, it appears that any person listed thereon does not have the
- 4 qualifications to serve as a juror or has served as a juror within two preceding years, the board
- 5 of jury selectors clerk of courts shall strike such the name from the list and draw another in its
- 6 place <u>if necessary</u>. The board <u>clerk of courts</u> shall adjust the number to be drawn to allow for
- 7 the elimination of the names of those disqualified.
- 8 The board of jury selectors clerk of courts shall record with the list of jurors the reasons for
- 9 disqualification of any person stricken from the master jury list.
