An Act to create a taskforce to study the creation of Indian medicaid managed care

3	BE IT EN	IACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
4	Section	1. There is established the Indian Medicaid Managed Care Model taskforce to study
5	the creat	ion of Indian medicaid managed care entities, as defined in 42 U.S.C. § 1396u-2(h),
6	in this sta	ate. The taskforce must consist of:
7	<u>(1)</u>	A representative from each federally recognized Indian tribe located wholly or
8		partially within the state, appointed by the appropriate tribal council;
9	<u>(2)</u>	The secretary of the Department of Social Services, or the secretary's designee;
LO	<u>(3)</u>	The secretary of the Department of Health, or the secretary's designee;
l1	<u>(4)</u>	The secretary of the Department of Tribal Relations, or the secretary's designee;
L2	<u>(5)</u>	Two members of the House of Representatives, appointed by the speaker of the
L3		House of Representatives;
L4	<u>(6)</u>	Two members of the Senate, appointed by the president pro tempore of the
L5		Senate;
L6	<u>(7)</u>	A representative of the United States Bureau of Indian Affairs, appointed by the
L7		director of the bureau; and
L8	<u>(8)</u>	The following members, appointed by the Executive Board of the Legislative
L9		Research Council:
20		(a) One member representing a healthcare provider;
21		(b) One member representing a healthcare insurance provider; and
22		(c) One healthcare administrator.
23		Any vacancy on the taskforce must be filled in the same manner as the original
24	<u>appoi</u>	ntment.
25		At the initial meeting, the members of the taskforce shall select one from among
26	thems	selves to serve as the chair and one to serve as the vice chair.
27		The Department of Health shall provide administrative support to the taskforce.

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The taskforce shall seek input from state and federal executive branch agencies,
representatives of the Indian tribes, representatives of the health care industry, and other
relevant stakeholders.
The taskforce shall report its findings and recommendations, together with any

The taskforce shall report its findings and recommendations, together with any proposed legislation, to the Governor, on or before December 1, 2028.

**Section 2.** This Act is effective beginning January 1, 2027.
