- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to allow certain school districts that do not receive state aid
- 2 to education to receive funding for certain students with limited English proficiency.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 13-13-82 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 13-13-82. An eligible school district shall receive an amount equal to the per student
- 6 allocation as defined in subdivision 13-13-10.1(4) multiplied by the number of eligible students
- 7 included in its fall enrollment as defined in subdivision 13-13-10.1(2A). An eligible school
- 8 district shall also receive an amount equal to the limited English proficiency (LEP) adjustment
- 9 calculated pursuant to subdivision 13-13-10.1(2D) for the number of eligible students who
- qualify for the adjustment under the terms stipulated in that subdivision.
