A LEGISLATIVE COMMEMORATION, Recognizing 2007 as the Year of the Coaches at Scotland High School.

WHEREAS, Gary Pepper was named the 2007 Track Coach of the Year upon leading the Scotland Boys' Track Team to runner-up status at the 2007 Boys' State Track Meet in Sioux Falls. Mr. Pepper led the Scotland Girls' Cross Country Team to runner-up status at the 2007 Girls' State Track Meet in Huron and was also named the 2007 Girls' Cross Country Coach of the Year. Mr. Pepper has committed more than thirty years to high school coaching; and
