- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide that a truancy complaint is grounds to refuse a
- 2 certificate for excuse from school attendance.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That chapter 13-27 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
- 5 follows:
- 6 If a truancy complaint pursuant to § 13-27-20 has been filed against any person having
- 7 control of a child of compulsory school age, the school board may refuse to grant a certificate
- 8 from school attendance until the truancy charges are resolved.
