- 2 Medicaid pursuant to the Affordable Care Act.
- 3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA, THE HOUSE
- 4 OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:
- 5 Section 1. That at the next general election held in the state, the following bill, which is
- 6 hereby agreed to, shall be submitted to the electors of the state for approval:
- 7 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: An Act to expand Medicaid pursuant to the Affordable Care Act.
- 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 9 Section 1. That chapter 28-6 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
- 10 follows:
- 11 The minimum income standard the Department of Social Services may impose on a person
- for eligibility for the medical assistance program established and operated pursuant to § 28-6-1
- and in accordance with Title XIX of the federal Social Security Act, as amended to January 1,
- 14 2004, is one hundred thirty-eight percent of the federal poverty level established by the Patient
