- 1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION, Recognizing the honor and remember flag as the
- 2 designated symbol of South Dakota's concern and commitment to honoring and
- 3 remembering all members of the United States Armed Forces who have lost their lives while
- 4 serving, or as a result of service, and their families.
- 5 WHEREAS, the honor and remember flag is a flag with a red and white background and
- 6 features an eternal flame inset to a yellow star with a blue border and features the words, "honor
- 7 and remember". A folded flag showing blue stars lies below the star; and
- 8 WHEREAS, the honor and remember flag's red background represents the blood shed by
- 9 brave men and women who sacrificed their lives for freedom, and the flag's white field and
- border recognizes the purity of that sacrifice. The flag's blue star is a symbol of active service
- in military conflict that dates back to World War I. The flag's gold star signifies the ultimate
- sacrifice of a warrior in active service who is not returning home and reflects the value of life
- given. The folded flag element highlights this nation's final tribute to a fallen service member

- and a family's sacrifice. The flag's flame symbolizes the eternal spirit of the departed; and
- WHEREAS, the honor and remember flag is a unifying symbol recognizing this nation's
- 3 solemn debt to the estimated one million six hundred thousand fallen service members
- 4 throughout history and the families and communities who mourn their loss:
- 5 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the House of Representatives of the Eighty-
- 6 Ninth Legislature of the State of South Dakota, the Senate concurring therein, that the honor and
- 7 remember flag is designated as South Dakota's emblem of service and sacrifice by the men and
- 8 women of the armed forces who have died while serving, and that the honor and remember flag
- 9 be displayed to remember that sacrifice; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislature encourages the display of the honor and
- 11 remember flag on all state and national holidays.
