Senate Bill 150

AMENDMENT 150A FOR THE INTRODUCED BILL

This bill has been extensively amended (hoghoused) and may no longer be consistent with the original intention of the sponsor.

1 **An Act to exempt one motor vehicle of a debtor from being taken by legal process.**

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

3 **Section 1. That § 43-45-2 be AMENDED:**

4 **43-45-2.** ~~The~~Except as otherwise provided by law, the following property
5 ~~mentioned in this section~~ is absolutely exempt from all such process, ~~any~~ levy, ~~process,~~
6 ~~or sale, except as otherwise provided by law:~~

- 7 (1) All of the debtor's family pictures;
- 8 (2) A pew or other sitting seating in any house of worship;
- 9 (3) A lot or lots in any burial ground;
- 10 (4) The debtor's family Bible and all schoolbooks used by the family, and all other
11 books used as a part of the family library, not exceeding in value two hundred
12 dollars in value;
- 13 (5) All wearing apparel and clothing of the debtor and his the debtor's family;
- 14 (6) The provisions for the debtor and his the debtor's family necessary for one year's
15 supply, either provided or growing, or both, and fuel necessary for one year;
- 16 (7) All property in this state of the judgment debtor if the there is a judgment is against
17 the debtor in favor of any state for failure to pay that state's income tax on benefits
18 received from a pension or other retirement plan while the judgment debtor was a
19 resident of this state;
- 20 (8) Any health aids aid professionally prescribed to the debtor or to a dependant a
21 dependent of the debtor;
- 22 (9) Any court ordered domestic support award of alimony, maintenance, or other
23 support of the debtor, which is not a gross or lump sum and does not exceed seven
24 hundred fifty dollars per month; and

1 (10) A debtor's interest in one motor vehicle, as defined in § 32-5-1, not to exceed five
2 thousand dollars in value over any security interests and liens upon on the vehicle.
