House Bill 1125**AMENDMENT 1125B
FOR THE HOUSE STATE AFFAIRS ENGROSSED BILL**

1 **An Act to create a taskforce to study the impact of artificial intelligence systems on**
2 **the state.**

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 **Section 1.** There is established a taskforce to study the continued technological development
5 and impact of artificial intelligence systems on the state. The taskforce shall consist of:

6 (1) The following members, appointed by the Executive Board of the Legislative
7 Research Council:

8 (a) Two members of the House of Representatives;

9 (b) Two members of the Senate;

10 (c) One member representing the health care industry;

11 (d) One member representing the banking and finance industry;

12 (e) One member representing the retail industry;

13 (f) One member representing the manufacturing industry;

14 (g) One member representing the technology industry;

15 (h) One individual employed by a school district as a teacher;

16 (i) One individual employed by a school district as an administrator;

17 (j) The auditor of a county with a population of fifteen thousand residents or
18 more;

19 (k) The auditor of a county with a population of fewer than fifteen thousand
20 residents;

21 (l) An official or employee of a municipality with a population of twenty
22 thousand residents or more;

23 (m) An official or employee of a municipality with a population of fewer than
24 twenty thousand residents; and

25 (n) The sheriff of a county or police chief of a municipality; and

26 (2) One member appointed by the Governor;

1 (3) One member appointed by the chief justice of the Supreme Court; and

2 (4) One member appointed by the Board of Regents.

3 A vacancy on the taskforce must be filled in the same manner as the original
4 appointment.

5 The executive board shall appoint one legislator to serve as the chair and one
6 legislator, from the opposite chamber, to serve as the vice chair. The Legislative Research
7 Council shall provide administrative support to the taskforce.

8 The taskforce shall report its findings and recommendations and any proposed
9 legislation, including whether the taskforce should be continued, to the executive board,
10 on or before December 1, 2028. The task force is dissolved upon the delivery of the report
11 to the executive board.
