#### SECOND READING AND CONSIDERATION OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

SB 60 restrict ownership of real property interests by certain prohibited entities and to provide for enforcement. (Senate Commerce and Energy Engrossed)

SB 72 extend the time for reverting moneys appropriated for the modernization of the state's enterprise resource planning systems. (Introduced)

SB 132 modify provisions related to the South Dakota Veterans Council. (Senate Military and Veterans Affairs Engrossed)

SB 137 establish procedures for anti-SLAPP actions to protect the exercise of a person's constitutional rights, including freedom of speech. (Senate Judiciary Engrossed)

SB 139 revise a provision related to the transportation of an inmate upon discharge from a correctional facility. (Senate Judiciary Engrossed)

SB 180 modify requirements regarding nondomiciled commercial driver licenses. (Introduced)

SB 197 modify the administration of the South Dakota-Ireland trade fund. (Senate Commerce and Energy Engrossed)

HB 1030 amend provisions pertaining to the timing of municipal elections. (Introduced)

HB 1060 remove the five percent calculation requirement from the county budgetary process. (Introduced)

HB 1080 allow a business owner who is a veteran to display military specialty plates on a noncommercial vehicle registered to the veteran's business and to limit personal liability to the business owner and veteran. (Senate Military and Veterans Affairs Engrossed)

HB 1088      remove the requirement that counties remit to municipalities an amount equal to the road levy for calendar years 1984, 1985, and 1986. (Introduced)

SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

SB 97      (Deferred from 15<sup>th</sup> LD) adjust a limit on the percentage increase in revenue payable from property taxes. (Introduced)

SB 122      establish the crime of failure to summon aid for a suicide attempt and provide a penalty therefor. (Senate Judiciary Engrossed)

SB 150      exempt one motor vehicle of a debtor from being taken by legal process. (Senate Judiciary Engrossed)

SB 195      repeal the expiration of a reduction in certain gross receipts and use tax rates. (Introduced)

SJR 504      proposing and submitting to the voters at the next general election an amendment to the Constitution of the State of South Dakota, providing for wagering on sporting events via mobile or electronic platform. (Introduced)
