#### SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

SB 60 (Removed from Consent Calendar) restrict ownership of real property interests by certain prohibited entities and to provide for enforcement.  
(Senate Commerce and Energy Engrossed)  
SB 67 make an appropriation for costs related to emergencies and disasters impacting the state and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)  
SB 68 make an appropriation for costs related to the suppression of wildfires impacting the state and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)  
SB 97 (Deferred from 18<sup>th</sup> LD) adjust a limit on the percentage increase in revenue payable from property taxes. (Introduced)  
SB 117 make an appropriation for the design and construction of a new soccer venue at South Dakota State University and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)  
SB 146 clarify the effect of the resignation of certain gubernatorial appointees.  
(Introduced)
