MOTIONS AND RESOLUTIONS

SB 195 (Intent to Reconsider Vote by Which Lost) repeal the expiration of a reduction in certain gross receipts and use tax rates. (Introduced)

HB 1035 modify provisions related to the licensure of public accountants. (Introduced)

SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

SB 208 require the award of certain disbursements to prevailing owners and taxpayers in appeals of property classifications or assessments. (Senate Judiciary Engrossed)
SB 224 provide a rebuttable presumption in favor of joint physical custody of a minor child. (Introduced)

HB 1201 authorize the use of bingo games, lotteries, and pull-tab devices by booster clubs. (House Commerce and Energy Engrossed)
