MOTIONS AND RESOLUTIONS

HCR 6011 encouraging the Executive Board of the Legislative Research Council to form an interim Neurohealth Safety Committee to study and assess the regulatory framework under which vapor product retail establishments operate.
(House Engrossed)

SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

SB 135 protect residents from increased utility costs and utility shortages caused by data centers and clarify authority to regulate data centers. (Introduced)
SB 150 (Deferred from 22nd LD) exempt one motor vehicle of a debtor from being taken by legal process. (Senate Judiciary Engrossed)
SB 208 (Deferred from 23rd LD) require the award of certain disbursements to prevailing owners and taxpayers in appeals of property classifications or assessments. (Senate Judiciary Engrossed)
SB 218 provide for the establishment of charter schools.
(Senate Education Engrossed)

SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

HB 1018 amend the reversion date for moneys appropriated to the Department of Education to improve and renovate the Cultural Heritage Center. (Introduced)
HB 1227 increase the annual fee required of an owner of an electric motor vehicle.
(House Engrossed)
