- SB 111 (Consideration of House Amendments) require that social media companies provide collected personal data of a user at the user's request and maintain transparent interoperability interfaces. (House Engrossed)
- SB 220 (Intent to Reconsider Vote by Which Lost) authorize a comprehensive study of juvenile correctional and residential facilities, to make an appropriation therefor, and to declare an emergency. (Senate Judiciary Engrossed)

SECOND READING AND CONSIDERATION OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

- HB 1027 update certain citations to federal regulations regarding pipeline safety inspections. (Introduced)
- HB 1049 protect electric infrastructure in this state. (House Engrossed)
- HB 1066 revise a provision related to theft by a contractor, subcontractor, or supplier. (Introduced)
- HB 1102 reschedule the date for filing certain annual reports. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed)
- HB 1126 revise a provision related to driving under the influence. (Introduced)
- HB 1164 establish the crime of fraudulent assisted reproduction and provide a penalty and civil liability therefor. (Introduced)
- HB 1234 revise provisions related to serving a subpoena in a contested case. (House Judiciary Engrossed)
- HB 1254 exempt any soil amendment used exclusively for agricultural purposes from sales tax. (House Engrossed)

HB 1264 eliminate the Agricultural Land Assessment Implementation and Oversight Advisory Task Force, and to provide that the Department of Revenue receive the submission of recommendations and provide a report on agricultural value. (Introduced)

SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

SB 37 make appropriations for water and environmental purposes and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)

SB 69 make an appropriation for the purchase of a new Division of Highway Patrol airplane and mission equipment and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)

SB 79 make an appropriation to the South Dakota Board of Technical Education to construct an advanced manufacturing laboratory space and classrooms on the campus of Southeast Technical College and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)

SB 136 make an appropriation for grants to support the purchase of personal protective equipment by volunteer fire departments and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)

SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

HB 1092 (Removed from Consent Calendar) update provisions pertaining to open records. (Introduced)

HB 1095 (Removed from Consent Calendar) modify provisions pertaining to the submission of a nominating petition. (House Engrossed)

HB 1099 (Removed from Consent Calendar) reschedule the pharmaceutical composition of crystalline polymorph psilocybin in a drug product approved by the Food and Drug Administration as a Schedule IV controlled substance. (Introduced)

HB 1107 (Deferred from 29th LD) modify restrictions on lands for certain public purposes. (Introduced)

HB 1193 (Removed from Consent Calendar) modify the provisions for a refund of taxes to disabled veterans and surviving spouses under certain property tax relief programs. (House Engrossed)

HB 1194 (Deferred from 29th LD) require that the Cosmetology Commission credit work experience for educational hours for certain out-of-state licensure applicants and to declare an emergency. (Senate Commerce and Energy Engrossed)

HJR 5001 proposing and submitting to the voters at the next general election an amendment to the Constitution of the State of South Dakota, requiring a declaration of necessity and clarifying public use of private property taken or damaged by eminent domain. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed)

CONFERENCE COMMITTEES APPOINTED THAT HAVE NOT REPORTED

SB 3A limit the types of residential improvements for which counties, municipalities, and townships may require a permit. (House Local Government Engrossed)
