### MOTIONS AND RESOLUTIONS

- HB 1102 (Consideration of Amendments) reschedule the date for filing certain annual reports. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed)
- HB 1194 (Consideration of Amendments) clarify authority for the Cosmetology Commission to credit work experience for educational hours for certain out-of-state licensure applicants, and to require the commission to promulgate rules therefor. (Senate Engrossed)

### CONSIDERATION OF REPORTS OF COMMITTEES (AMENDED BILLS)

### CONSIDERATION OF REPORTS OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEES

SB 3 limit the types of residential improvements for which counties, municipalities, and townships may require a permit. (House Local Government Engrossed)

### SECOND READING AND CONSIDERATION OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

- SB 49 safeguard the integrity, privacy, and security of genetic data and provide a civil penalty therefor. (House Judiciary Engrossed)
- SB 135 protect residents from increased utility costs and utility shortages caused by data centers and clarify authority to regulate data centers. (House State Affairs Engrossed)

### SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- SB 125 (Deferred from 28<sup>th</sup> LD) establish the homeowner tax reduction fund. (Senate Taxation Engrossed)
- SB 37 make appropriations for water and environmental purposes and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)
- SB 69 make an appropriation for the purchase of a new Division of Highway Patrol airplane and mission equipment and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)
- SB 79 make an appropriation to the South Dakota Board of Technical Education to construct an advanced manufacturing laboratory space and classrooms on the campus of Southeast Technical College and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)

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- SB 136 make an appropriation for grants to support the purchase of personal protective equipment by volunteer fire departments and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)
- SB 220 authorize a comprehensive study of juvenile correctional and residential facilities, to make an appropriation therefor, and to declare an emergency. (Senate Judiciary Engrossed)
- SB 44 (Removed from Consent Calendar) establish investigative subpoena authority to gather business records in certain investigations. (Senate Judiciary Engrossed)
- SB 151 require the publication of the results of an election for precinct committeeman or committeewoman and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)
- SB 175 require that an individual provide proof of citizenship when registering to vote and to declare an emergency. (Senate Engrossed)
- SJR 508 proposing and submitting to the voters at the next general election, amendments to the Constitution of the State of South Dakota, removing the lieutenant governor as presiding officer of the Senate. (Introduced)
- SB 228 modify provisions for a tax increment financing district. (Senate Taxation Engrossed)
- SB 40 revise the compliance requirements for limitations on foreign ownership of agricultural land. (Introduced)
- SB 124 temporarily prohibit the manufacture, sale, and distribution of any product containing cell-cultured protein, and to provide a penalty therefor. (Senate Agriculture and Natural Resources Engrossed)
