SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

HB 1006 (Removed from Consent Calendar) create a taskforce to study the creation of Indian medicaid managed care entities in the state.
(House Health and Human Services Engrossed)

- HB 1135 (Deferred from 33rd LD) make an appropriation to enhance the economic health of South Dakota. (Introduced)
- HB 1148 (Removed from Consent Calendar) adopt the respiratory care interstate compact. (Introduced)
- HB 1149 (Removed from Consent Calendar) adopt the athletic trainer licensure compact. (Introduced)
- HB 1184 define man and woman throughout the state. (House State Affairs Engrossed)
- HB 1215 authorize counties and municipalities to issue a license for a cigar bar. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed)
- HB 1241 modify the requirements for public notice of a hearing prior to a vote to impose an excess tax levy, and to modify requirements to refer an excess tax levy of a school district to a vote. (Senate Taxation Engrossed)
- HB 1249 amend provisions pertaining to the School Finance Accountability Board, and the process by which a recommendation of the board is approved. (House Appropriations Engrossed)
- HB 1253 adjust the assessment methodology for owner-occupied single-family dwellings and nonagricultural property. (Senate Taxation Engrossed)
- HB 1274 prohibit the dispensing, distribution, sale, or advertisement of certain articles or things for purposes of an unlawful abortion and provide a criminal and civil penalty therefor. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed)
- HB 1302 (Deferred from 33rd LD) address issues facing South Dakota. (Introduced)
- HB 1303 (Deferred from 33rd LD) promote the future success and development of South Dakota. (Introduced)
- HB 1323 amend the time required for filing a petition referring an ordinance or resolution of a political subdivision. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed)
