- HB 1200 (Consideration of amendments) make an appropriation for victim services provided by nonprofit organizations. (Senate Engrossed)
- HB 1209 (Consideration of amendments) require employment verification eligibility through the e-verify program and to provide a penalty therefor. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed)

SB 106, SB 119, SB 121

SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- SB 244 (Deferred from 33rd LD) address issues facing South Dakota. (Introduced)
- SB 74 transfer moneys to the general fund from the budget reserve fund and the general revenue replacement fund, and to declare an emergency. (House Appropriations Engrossed)
- SB 221 regulate the retail sale of nicotine products, and to provide a penalty therefor. (House Commerce and Energy Engrossed)
- SB 245 create the homeowner property tax reduction fund, and to transfer moneys to the homeowner property tax reduction fund. (House State Affairs Engrossed)
- SB 106 modify the amount required to be set aside for extraordinary expenses incurred in providing special education programs. (House Appropriations Engrossed)
- SB 119 create the capitol restoration fund and to transfer moneys thereto. (House Appropriations Engrossed)
- SB 121 transfer moneys and make an appropriation for the replacement of the Richmond Lake dam and spillway and to declare an emergency. (House Appropriations Engrossed)
- SB 219 require that a state agency consult with the Aeronautics Commission prior to purchasing, transferring, or disposing of a state owned and operated aircraft. (Senate Engrossed)
- SB 102 modify the distribution of gaming revenues. (Senate Appropriations Engrossed)
- SB 120 make an appropriation for the economic development of South Dakota. (Introduced)
