1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to make an appropriation to rehabilitate certain state-owned  
2 rail lines and to declare an emergency.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. The state treasurer shall transfer six million dollars (\$6,000,000) from the  
5 property tax reduction fund to the general fund.

6 Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of six million dollars  
7 (\$6,000,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, to the Department of Transportation to  
8 rehabilitate the state-owned rail line between Chamberlain and Presho.

9 Section 3. The secretary of transportation shall approve vouchers and the state auditor shall  
10 draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.



1       Section 4. Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated by  
2       June 30, 2018, shall revert in accordance with the procedures prescribed in chapter 4-8.

3       Section 5. Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of the state government and its  
4       existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in  
5       full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
