**SENATE BILL NO. 18**

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH CERTAIN ADMINISTRATIVE PROVISIONS REGARDING CHARITABLE RAFFLES, LOTTERIES, AND BINGO AND TO MAKE VIOLATIONS OF THESE PROVISIONS SUBJECT TO THE DECEPTIVE TRADE PRACTICE AND CONSUMER PROTECTION ACT.

A prison/jail population cost estimate statement has been requested on SB 18 due to the establishment of new penalties in section 2(14) of this Act.

This Act describes a crime that if prosecuted could result in a prison or jail sentence. However, a violation and prosecution is likely to be rare. Therefore the impact on prison or jail populations is estimated to be low.
