- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to repeal certain requirements regarding the handlebar
- 2 height on motorcycles.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 32-20-3 be repealed.
- 5 32-20-3. No person may operate on a public street or highway a motorcycle equipped with
- 6 a handlebar positioned so that the grips of the handlebar are at or above shoulder height of the
- 7 person when sitting astride the seat. A violation of this section is a petty offense.
