- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 7-7-2.1 be amended to read:
- 5 7-7-2.1. The chairman chair of the board of county commissioners at his discretion may
- 6 close the courthouse in case of emergency or severe weather and each such closing shall be for
- 7 no more than one business day. The public shall be adequately notified. An emergency for the
- 8 purpose of this section is an unforeseen occurrence or combination of circumstances which that
- 9 calls for immediate action or remedy.
- Section 2. That § 7-8-24 be amended to read:
- 7-8-24. The board of county commissioners shall have power to may appropriate funds for
- the purpose of defraying necessary expense of proper observance of Memorial Day each year.
- Section 3. That § 7-8-19 be amended to read:
- 7-8-19. The board of county commissioners shall have the power to may preserve order

when sitting as a board and may punish contempts by fines not exceeding five by imposing a

- 2 <u>contempt fine not to exceed twenty-five</u> dollars or by imprisonment in the county jail not
- 3 exceeding to exceed twenty-four hours. It The board may enforce obedience to all its orders by
- 4 attachment or other compulsory process.

- 8-4-3. Each person elected or appointed to any township office, shall, within ten days after
- 7 receiving notice of election or appointment and before entering upon the discharge of the
- 8 officer's duties, take and subscribe an oath or affirmation as required by § 3-1-5. All such
- 9 official oaths Each oath shall be immediately filed in the office of the county auditor by the last
- 10 <u>day of March</u>. No fee may be charged or received by any officer for administering or filing the
- official oath, or for filing or recording any township officer's official bond.
- 12 Section 5. That § 8-10-2 be amended to read:
- 8-10-2. It shall be the duty of the <u>The</u> township clerk, within three days after the board of
- supervisors has made the levy of taxes, to shall notify the county auditor by the last day of
- March of the amount of the taxes levied, who by the board of supervisors. The county auditor
- shall enter the same amount on the county tax list to be collected by the county treasurer as
- 17 county taxes are collected.
