## HOUSE BILL NO. 1019

Introduced by: The Committee on Agriculture and Natural Resources at the request of the  
Department of Agriculture

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain provisions related to milk sampling and  
2 grading licenses and tester and grader licenses.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 40-32-13 be amended to read:

5 40-32-13. ~~Applications~~ An application for a sampling and grading license shall be made on  
6 forms prescribed and provided by the secretary of agriculture. A fee of fifty dollars shall be  
7 submitted with the application. A license shall be issued to persons for sampling and grading  
8 of milk at a milk plant, or for the operator of a bulk tank truck picking up milk at the farm, upon  
9 satisfactory completion of ~~that part of the~~ an examination pertaining to sampling and grading;  
10 ~~and upon receipt of the application and a fee of fifty dollars. These licenses~~ and an evaluation  
11 of sampling methods. Each license shall be stamped, "For sampling and grading only." "Sampler  
12 Only" or "Bulk Hauler."

13 Section 2. That § 40-32-14 be amended to read:

14 40-32-14. After successful completion of the examination required by §§ 40-32-12 and 40-  
15 32-13, the secretary of agriculture shall issue a tester and grader's license ~~which shall be valid~~



1 ~~for one year from date of issue, unless suspended or revoked. Should any applicant fail to~~  
2 ~~qualify, the secretary shall refund three dollars of the fee advanced as license fee~~ or sampling  
3 and grading license. Each license is valid for one year or any fraction thereof and terminated on  
4 July first of each year.

5 Section 3. That § 40-32-15 be amended to read:

6 40-32-15. The secretary of agriculture may withhold a tester and grader's license or a  
7 sampling and grading license from any applicant ~~he may deem unworthy~~ who does not meet the  
8 licensing requirements.
