## SENATE BILL NO. 40

Introduced by: The Committee on Commerce and Energy at the request of the Board of Technical Professions

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise signature and seal requirements for the Board of 2 **Technical Professions.** 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA: 4 Section 1. That § 36-18A-44 be amended to read: 5 36-18A-44. Any licensed professional engineer, architect, land surveyor, and landscape 6 architect shall procure and use an appropriate seal. The seal shall contain the following information: 7 8 (1) The name, South Dakota; 9 (2) Licensee's name; 10 (3) License number; and 11 (4) The appropriate title or combination of titles: Professional Engineer, Architect, Land 12 Surveyor, Landscape Architect. The seal shall be legible and shall have an outer circle with a two-inch diameter measuring 13 14 at least one inch and no greater than two inches and an inner circle with a one and one-fourth 15 inch diameter measuring five-eighths of the diameter of the outer circle. Titles may be prefixed

1 with the words, Licensed or Registered. The seal may be an embossed seal, a rubber stamp, a

- 2 computer-generated seal, or other facsimile found acceptable to the board. The licensee's
- 3 original written signature and the date shall be adjacent to or across the seal. Petroleum release
- 4 assessors and remediators, or interns, may not obtain or use any  $\underline{a}$  seal.
- 5 Section 2. That § 36-18A-45 be amended to read:
- 6 36-18A-45. The application of the licensee's seal and signature and the date constitutes
- 7 certification that the work on which it was applied was done by the licensee or under the
- 8 licensee's responsible charge. The seal, signature, and date shall be placed in such a manner that
- 9 can be legibly reproduced on the following:
- 10 (1) All originals, copies, tracings, electronic submittals, or other reproducibles
- 11 reproductions of all final drawings, specifications, reports, plats, plans, land surveys,
- design information, and calculations prepared by the licensee or under the licensee's
- responsible charge when presented to a client or any public or governmental agency.
- A licensee may not review or check technical submissions of another licensed
- professional or unlicensed person and seal the documents as the licensee's own work;
- 16 (2) Preliminary work shall contain a note that the submittal is Not for Construction,
- Preliminary, or other such explanation that it is not final; and
- 18 (3) In the case of multiple seals documents for projects which involve multiple licensees
- of more than one technical profession, the title or index sheet may shall be sealed,
- signed, and dated by all involved the prime professional in responsible charge of
- 21 <u>coordinating the various technical professions involved in the project</u>. In addition,
- each sheet shall be sealed, signed, and dated by the licensee or licensees who
- 23 <u>prepared or who are in responsible for charge of that sheet;</u>

1		have the computer-generated seal removed from the original file. The electronic
2		media shall have the following inserted in lieu of the seal, signature, and date: This
3		document originally issued and sealed by (name of licensee/sealer), (title), (license
4		number), on (date of sealing). This media should not be considered a certified
5		document;
6	<del>(5)</del>	Drawings, reports, or documents that are signed and sealed using a digital method
7		shall have an electronic authentication process attached to or logically associated
8		with the electronic documents. The digital signature shall be:
9		(a) Unique to the person using it;
10		(b) Capable of verification;
11		(c) Under the sole control of the person using it; and
12		(d) Linked to a document in such a manner that the digital signature is invalidated
13		if any data in the document is changed.

15	36-18	A-45.1. Each drawing, report, or document that is signed and sealed using a digital
16	signature s	shall have an electronic authentication process attached to or logically associated with
17	the electro	onic document. The licensee's use of a digital signature is optional and, if used, shall
18	be:	
19	<u>(1)</u>	Unique to the licensee;
20	<u>(2)</u>	Capable of verification;
21	<u>(3)</u>	Under the sole control of the licensee using it; and
22	<u>(4)</u>	Linked to a document in such a manner that the digital signature is invalidated if any

- 1 set forth in subdivision 36-18A-45(5) provided in this section. Any hard copy printed from the
- 2 transmitted electronic file shall bear the facsimile of the signature and seal and shall be a
- 3 confirmation that the electronic file was not altered after the initial digital signing of the file.
- 4 Any alterations to the file shall cause the facsimile of the signature to be voided.
