- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to set daylight savings time as the permanent year-round
- 2 time for the state of South Dakota.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary by the United States relating to
- 6 the adoption of daylight savings time by all of the states, the state of South Dakota elects to
- 7 reject standard time and elects to continue use in force daylight savings time.
- 8 The provisions of this section may not be construed to affect the standard time established
- 9 by the United States law governing the movements of common carriers engaged in interstate
- 10 commerce or the time for performance if an act by an officer or department of the United States,
- as established by statute, lawful order, rule, or regulation of the United States or an agency
- 12 thereof.
