## SENATE BILL NO. 60

Introduced by: Senators Olson, Curd, Ewing, Greenfield (Brock), Jensen (Phil), Monroe, Omdahl, and Rampelberg and Representatives Marty, Campbell, Latterell, May, Qualm, Schaefer, Verchio, and Zikmund

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to set daylight savings time as the permanent year-round  
2 time for the state of South Dakota.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:

5 Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary by the United States relating to  
6 the adoption of daylight savings time by all of the states, the state of South Dakota elects to  
7 reject standard time and elects to continue use in force daylight savings time.

8 The provisions of this section may not be construed to affect the standard time established  
9 by the United States law governing the movements of common carriers engaged in interstate  
10 commerce or the time for performance if an act by an officer or department of the United States,  
11 as established by statute, lawful order, rule, or regulation of the United States or an agency  
12 thereof.
