- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to require persons operating bicycles under certain
- 2 conditions to stop and allow faster vehicles to pass.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 32-20B-5 be amended to read:
- 5 32-20B-5. Any person operating a bicycle upon a roadway at less than the normal speed of
- 6 traffic at the time and place and under the conditions then existing shall ride as close as
- 7 practicable to the right-hand curb or edge of the roadway. However, a person operating a bicycle
- 8 may move from the right-hand curb or edge of the roadway to overtake and pass another bicycle
- 9 or vehicle proceeding in the same direction, to prepare for a left turn at an intersection or into
- 10 a private road or roadway, or to avoid conditions including, but not limited to, fixed or moving
- objects, parked or moving vehicles, bicycles, pedestrians, animals, or surface hazards, or
- 12 substandard width lanes that make it unsafe to continue along the right-hand curb or edge. For
- purposes of this section, a "substandard width lane" is a lane that is too narrow for a bicycle and
- 14 vehicle to travel safely side by side within the lane.

- 1 If a person is operating a bicycle within a no passing zone on a roadway that has no shoulder
- 2 or a shoulder of less than three feet in width, the person shall stop the bicycle, move the bicycle
- 3 off the roadway, and allow a faster vehicle to pass.
- 4 A violation of this section is a Class 2 misdemeanor.
