- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to set a minimum size for a sign about zoning changes or

- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That chapter 11-4 be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- 5 If a landowner petitions a governing board of a municipality for a change in the zoning
