1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to exempt certain purchases from certain bidding 2 requirements. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA: 4 Section 1. That § 5-18A-11 be amended to read: 5 5-18A-11. Unless otherwise specified by statute, purchases of supplies and services under 6 twenty-five fifty thousand dollars shall be made as follows: 7 (1) Notwithstanding other provisions of chapter 5-18A or 5-18D, the Bureau of 8 Administration may authorize state agencies and institutions to make purchases of 9 supplies over four thousand dollars and under twenty-five fifty thousand dollars by 10 obtaining three quotes from different vendors. If three quotes cannot be obtained, the 11 Bureau of Administration may approve the purchase if in the best interest of the state, 12 require additional quotes to be obtained, or require the purchase be advertised for 13 bids; 14 (2) State purchases of supplies under four thousand dollars may be made in accordance 15 with procedures established by the purchasing agency in the best interests of the state;

1 (3) State purchases of services under twenty-five <u>fifty</u> thousand dollars may be made in

2 accordance with procedures established by the purchasing agency in the best interests

- 4 (4) For all other purchasing agencies, purchases under twenty-five fifty thousand dollars
- 5 may be made in accordance with procedures established by the purchasing agency.
- 6 No purchases may be artificially divided to constitute a small purchase under this section.
- 7 Section 2. That § 5-18A-14 be amended to read:

5-18A-14. If the purchasing agency intends to enter into a contract for any public improvement, supplies, or services that involves the expenditure of fifty thousand dollars or more, or a contract for the purchase of supplies or services; other than professional services, that involves the expenditure of twenty-five fifty thousand dollars or more, the purchasing agency shall advertise for bids or proposals. The advertisement shall appear as a legal notice in the appointed legal newspaper. The advertisement shall be printed at least twice, with the first publication at least ten days before opening of bids or the deadline for the submission of proposals. The first publication shall be in each official newspaper of the purchasing agency, and the second publication may be in any legal newspaper of the state chosen by the purchasing agency. If the purchasing agency has no official newspaper, the first publication shall be made in a legal newspaper with general circulation in the jurisdiction of the purchasing agency to be selected by the purchasing agency. The advertisement shall state the time and place where the bids will be opened or the deadline for the submission of proposals. In each notice, the

purchasing agency shall reserve the right to reject any or all bids or proposals.
