WHEREAS, Chief David Beautiful Bald Eagle is an inspirational father to twenty-five children, and is a grandfather, great-grandfather, and great-grandfather residing on the Cheyenne River Reservation near Takini, South Dakota, where he remains active in community affairs; and

WHEREAS, Chief David Beautiful Bald Eagle has served as a mentor and friend to many, as he is a respected leader and Chief for the World Organization of United Native Nations and founder of Drumming Society for Young People, which counters drug and alcohol abuse among young people:
