- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to authorize township boards to prohibit the operation of
- 2 certain off-road vehicles along township highways.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 32-20-12.1 be amended to read:
- 5 32-20-12.1. Notwithstanding the provisions of § 32-20-12, the Transportation Commission
- 6 or, any board of county commissioners, or any board of township supervisors by ordinance may
- 7 prohibit the operation of off-road vehicles in any highway ditch along any section of highway
- 8 under its jurisdiction. However, neither the Transportation Commission nor any board of county
- 9 commissioners nor any board of township supervisors may prohibit an off-road vehicle from
- 10 crossing one side of the highway to the other. This section does not affect off-road vehicles used
- in normal agricultural operation or service vehicles of any utility while in the line of duty for
- the utility. For the purposes of this section, the term, utility, means any provider of electric, gas,
- water, sewer, pipeline, or telecommunications service.
- Notice of any restriction made pursuant to this section shall be given by placing and

- 1 maintaining regulatory signs at each end of the section of highway and at each point of
- 2 intersection. The signs shall be of substantial construction which conspicuously indicates the
- 3 restriction.
